

A Comparison of the 1st and 2nd Advents of Christ

Heb. 9:27,28 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, ²⁸so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

Now, even though we are probably the most familiar with the 1st Coming of Christ, it is the 2nd Coming that gets the most ink in the Bible:

- References to the 2nd Coming outnumber references to the 1st Coming by a factor of 8 to 1.
- Scholars count 1,845 biblical references to the 2nd Coming.
- His return is emphasized in no less than 17 Old Testament books and 7 out of every 10 chapters in the New Testament.
- Jesus Himself referred to His return 21 times.
- The 2nd Coming is second only to faith as the most dominant subject in the New Testament.

Pattern of Prophecy:
