

## Learning to Love Sermon Series

**Week 1.** Don't fall in love, commit to love.

**1 John 4:21** And he has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother.

**Week 2.** Don't force love, meet love (Christ).

**1 John 4:10** This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

**Week 3.** Don't live under the curse of self-love, live in the freedom of true love.

**1 Corinthians 13:1-3**

<sup>1</sup> If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.

<sup>2</sup> If I have *the gift of* prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

<sup>3</sup> And if I give all my possessions to feed *the poor*, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.

**Week 4.** Don't follow your emotions, fight your emotions.

**1 Corinthians 13:4-5** Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, .... it is not easily angered.

**Week 5.** Don't feed on love, make it a mission to love

**1 Corinthians 13:5** Love is not self-seeking.

**Week 6.** Don't embrace evil, rejoice with truth.

**1 Corinthians 13:6** Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.

**1 Corinthians 13:7** Love always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

**1 Corinthians 13:5** Love keeps no record of wrongs.
