Story of Ruth

Ruth 1:19-21 (ESV) So the two of them went on until they came to Bethlehem. And when they came to Bethlehem, the whole town was stirred because of them. And the women said, "Is this Naomi?" ²⁰ She said to them, "Do not call me Naomi; call me Mara, for the <u>Almighty</u> (*Shaddai*)has dealt very bitterly with me. ²¹ I went away full, and the <u>LORD</u> (*Yahweh*) has brought me back empty.
