Dead in sin

¹ And you were dead in your trespasses and sins,

² in which you formerly walked <u>according to (under control of)</u> the course of this world, <u>according to (under the control of)</u> the prince of the power of the air, of the <u>spirit that is now working</u> in the sons of disobedience.

³ Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and <u>were by nature</u> <u>children of wrath</u>, even as the rest.

Made alive

⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

⁵ even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us <u>alive</u> together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

Cleansed

⁶ and <u>raised</u> us up with Him, and <u>seated</u> us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus,

⁷ so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Humbled

⁸ For by grace you have been <u>saved</u> through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God;

⁹ not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.
