There are 4 types of friends referred to in 2 Tim:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Friends
  - A Fair weather Friend is one who \_\_\_\_\_ when the going gets tough. (1:15; 4:10,16)
  
  - A Fair weather friend is often a \_\_\_\_\_ friend. (2 Tim. 1:15; 2 Tim. 4:16)

- \_\_\_\_\_ Friends

The downward drift of Demas...(Philemon 24; Colossians 4:14; 2 Tim. 4:10)  
fellow laborer (Philemon 24).

"Demas greets you" (see Colossians 4:14).

Demas had forsaken Paul altogether (2 Timothy 4:10)
