

## Hebrews 5:1-14

### **Hebrews 5:1–6**

For every high priest taken from among men is appointed on behalf of men in things pertaining to God, in order to offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins; he can deal gently with the ignorant and misguided, since he himself also is beset with weakness; and because of it he is obligated to offer *sacrifices* for sins, as for the people, so also for himself.

And no one takes the honor to himself, but *receives it* when he is called by God, even as Aaron was.

So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him, “You are My Son, Today I have begotten You”; just as He says also in another *passage*, “You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.”

### **Exodus 20:3–17: The Ten Commandments**

1. You shall have no other gods before Me. **1 Corinthians 8:4-6.**
  
2. You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments. **Acts 17:29, 19:26; Romans 1:18-23.**
  
3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain. **Matthew 5:33-37; James 5:12.**
  
4. Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath of the Lord your God; *in it* you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter, your male or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you. For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; therefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day and made it holy. **Romans 14:5-6; Galatians 4:9-11; Hebrews 10:24-25; Acts 2:42-47; Colossians 2:16-17; 1 Timothy 4:3-5.**
  
5. Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the Lord your God gives you. **Ephesians 6:1-3.**
  
6. You shall not murder. **Galatians 5:18-26; 1 John 3:14-15.**
  
7. You shall not commit adultery. **Hebrews 13:4; Ephesians 5:3-5.**
  
8. You shall not steal. **Ephesians 4:28.**
  
9. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. **Ephesians 4:30-32.**
  
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor. **Hebrews 13:5-6; 1 Corinthians 6:10-11.**
