#### **Judges 2:6-13 (NIV)**

- <sup>6</sup> After Joshua had dismissed the Israelites, they went to take possession of the land, each to his own inheritance.
- <sup>7</sup> The people served the LORD throughout the lifetime of Joshua and of the elders who outlived him and who had seen all the great things the LORD had done for Israel.
- <sup>8</sup> Joshua son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died at the age of a hundred and ten.
- <sup>9</sup> And they buried him in the land of his inheritance, at Timnath Heres in the hill country of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash.
- <sup>10</sup> After that whole generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation grew up, who did not know the LORD or what he had done for Israel.

#### **Deuteronomy 6:1-9 (NIV)**

- <sup>1</sup>These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess,
- <sup>2</sup> so that you, your children and their children after <sup>4</sup> Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.
- <sup>5</sup> Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.
- <sup>6</sup>These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.
- <sup>7</sup> Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.
- <sup>8</sup> Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.
- <sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.
