- 23 For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which <u>he is</u> the Savior.
- ²⁴ Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything.
- ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her
- ²⁶ to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word,
- ²⁷ and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
