He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him is true,

Exodus 6:1-9 Then the LORD said to Moses, "Now you shall see what I will do to Pharaoh; "I am the LORD; and I appeared to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, as God Almighty, but *by* My name, LORD, I did not make Myself known to them.

"I also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land in which they sojourned. "Furthermore I have heard the groaning of the sons of Israel, because the Egyptians are holding them in bondage, and I have remembered My covenant.

"Say, therefore, to the sons of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from their bondage. I will also redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

'Then I will take you for My people, and I will be your God; and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

'I will bring you to the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and I will give it to you *for* a possession; I am the LORD.'"

Joshua 24:3-14 'Then I took your father Abraham from beyond the River, ...⁴'To Isaac I gave Jacob and Esau, and to Esau I gave Mount Seir to possess it;.... I sent Moses and Aaron, and I plagued Egypt by what I did in its midst; and afterward I brought you out.

'I brought your fathers out of Egypt, and you came to the sea;'But when they cried out to the LORD, He put darkness between you and the Egyptians, and brought the sea upon them and covered them; and your own eyes saw what I did in Egypt.'Then I brought you into the land of the Amorites who lived beyond the Jordan, and they fought with you; and I gave them into your hand, and you took possession of their land when I destroyed them before you.....

¹⁵ and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
