# Sandals of the Gospel wk 8

1. Put on the Sandals of the Gospel (death by neglect).

## John 8:44 (NIV)

<sup>44</sup> You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desire. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him.

2. A well-known war tactic throughout history has been to starve the enemy.

## 2 Kings 6:24-29 (NASB)

<sup>24</sup> Now it came about after this, that Ben-hadad king of Aram gathered all his army and went up and besieged Samaria.

<sup>25</sup> There was a great famine in Samaria; and behold, they besieged it, until a donkey's head was sold for eighty *shekels* of silver, and a fourth of a kab of dove's dung for five *shekels* of silver.

<sup>26</sup> As the king of Israel was passing by on the wall a woman cried out to him, saying, "Help, my lord, O king!"

<sup>27</sup> He said, "If the LORD does not help you, from where shall I help you? From the threshing floor, or from the wine press?"

<sup>28</sup> And the king said to her, "What is the matter with you?" And she answered, "This woman said to me, 'Give your son that we may eat him today, and we will eat my son tomorrow.'

<sup>29</sup> "So we boiled my son and ate him; and I said to her on the next day, 'Give your son, that we may eat him'; but she has hidden her son."

<sup>8</sup> When these lepers came to the outskirts of the camp, they entered one tent and ate and drank, and carried from there silver and gold and clothes, and went and hid *them*; and they returned and entered another tent and carried from there *also*, and went and hid *them*.

<sup>9</sup> Then they said to one another, "We are not doing right. This day is a day of good news, but we are keeping silent; if we wait until morning light, punishment will overtake us. Now therefore come, let us go and tell the king's household."

**2 Kings 7:3-16 (NASB)**

<sup>3</sup> Now there were four leprous men at the entrance of the gate; and they said to one another, "Why do we sit here until we die?"

**2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (NIV)**

<sup>3</sup> And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing.

<sup>4</sup> The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

4. Satan is passionate about starving our homes from the Gospel of Peace.

**Psalms 127:1-2 (NIV)**

<sup>1</sup> Unless the LORD builds the house, its builders labor in vain. Unless the LORD

watches over the city, the watchmen stand guard in vain.

<sup>2</sup> In vain you rise early and stay up late, toiling for food to eat-- for he grants sleep to those he loves.

## 5. Satan is passionate about starving our churches from the Gospel of Peace.

### **Jeremiah 10:21 (NASB)**

<sup>21</sup> For the shepherds have become stupid And have not sought the LORD;  
Therefore they have not prospered, And all their flock is scattered.

### **Jeremiah 23:1-2 (NASB)**

<sup>1</sup> "Woe to the shepherds who are destroying and scattering the sheep of My pasture!" declares the LORD.

<sup>2</sup> Therefore thus says the LORD God of Israel concerning the shepherds who are tending My people: "You have scattered My flock and driven them away, and have not attended to them;

### **Jeremiah 23:30-32 (NASB)**

<sup>30</sup> "Therefore behold, I am against the prophets," declares the LORD, "who steal My words from each other.

<sup>31</sup> "Behold, I am against the prophets," declares the LORD, "who use their tongues and declare, '*The Lord declares.*'"

<sup>32</sup> "Behold, I am against those who have prophesied false dreams," declares the LORD, "and related them and led My people astray by their falsehoods and reckless boasting; yet I did not send them or command them, nor do they furnish this people the slightest benefit," declares the LORD.

### **2 Timothy 2:20-26 (NASB)**

<sup>24</sup> The Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged,

<sup>25</sup> with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth,

<sup>26</sup> and they may come to their senses *and escape* from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will.

6. Satan is passionate about starving our world from the Gospel of Peace.

**Galatians 3:22 (NIV)**

<sup>22</sup> But the Scripture declares that the whole world is a prisoner of sin, so that what was promised, being given through faith in Jesus Christ, might be given to those who believe.

**Matthew 24:14 (NASB)**

<sup>14</sup> "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come.

**Mark 16:15 (NASB)**

<sup>15</sup> And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

**Romans 15:20 (NASB)**

<sup>20</sup> And thus I aspired to preach the gospel, not where Christ was *already* named.....

7. Satan is passionate about starving our country from the Gospel of Peace.

**James 1:14-15 (NASB)**

<sup>14</sup> But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust.

<sup>15</sup> Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death.

8. A Christian's silence would be contrary to the divine purpose of God saving us.

**1 Peter 2:9**

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the Excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

9. We must put on the armor of God every day and wear the Sandals of the Gospel of Peace.

**Isaiah 52:7 (NASB)**

<sup>7</sup> How lovely on the mountains Are the feet of him who brings good news, Who announces peace And brings good news of happiness, Who announces salvation, *And* says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

**John 7:38 (NASB)**

<sup>38</sup> "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'"

**Ephesians 6:10-17 (NASB)**

<sup>10</sup> Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.

<sup>11</sup> Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil..... <sup>14</sup> Stand firm therefore..... <sup>15</sup> and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE;
