## The Believer's Family (pt. 9) The Mystery of Marriage

## Ephesians 5:22-33 (NASB)

- <sup>22</sup> Wives, *be subject* to your own husbands, as to the Lord.
- <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body.
- <sup>24</sup> But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.
- <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,
- <sup>26</sup> so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,
- <sup>27</sup> that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.
- <sup>28</sup> So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself;
- <sup>29</sup> for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are members of His body.
- <sup>31</sup> FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND SHALL BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH.
- <sup>32</sup> This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church.
- <sup>33</sup> Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to love his own wife even as himself, and the wife must *see to it* that she respects her husband.
