Dear Parents;

We are starting a new digital check in system for children ages babies thru 5th grade during the weekend KidZone classes. (Kids in 6th – 12th grade will not be using the check-in system this year). This new process will begin the weekend of September 15th & 16th. Children's safety is a priority at JBC, and this new system will be very helpful in keeping our kids safe.

Enclosed in this letter are 2 parent cards with a bar code for your family. That code is tied in with the JBC attendance/servant keeper program. By scanning the card when you arrive, it will print 3 stickers for each child you check in. One sticker will be for the child, 1 for the parent and 1 for the teacher. Children must have a sticker to check into the classroom, and then parents/adults will have the matching sticker to check out the child. This greatly increases our safety for children. We will have 2 check-in areas to help cut down on long lines. One will be in the foyer by the chapel, and the other by the south end of the gym. There will be a check in computer in the infant nursery, too.

Also enclosed is the yearly form to fill out for your children. Please bring it with you to church or fill it out when you check in your child. **Important to note** is that we need a current cell phone number to put on your child's sticker. That information is to be put at the top of the form. Remember to write down any allergies, too.

Other things to keep in mind:

- * If you forget your card you go to the manned check in station and they will check you in manually.
- * If you lose your check-out sticker you will need to go back to the manned check in station to get another sticker.
- * Parents/adults need to check in and check out children, older siblings still will not be allowed to pick up kids.
- * If you want to have another adult pick up your child give them the check-out sticker.
- * You can take a picture of your card with your phone and it will work on the scanner. Just make sure there is no reflection, and all the code can be easily read.

As with any new program it may be a bit slow in the beginning, but as we get the kinks figured out it should go quickly and be easy for everyone to use. Please be patient with this new change.
